Stephanie was one of 55 girls from 55 countries who had qualified to enter the contest. Not only did she come in the Top 10, but she also won the Miss Friendship award.

Being able to speak eight languages certainly helped Stephanie communicate with the other contestants.

Each morning, all finalists received a booklet with the schedule, required to wear, parades planned for all sponsors, press conferences, excursions such as the famous Twin Towers of Malaysia, etc.
