The Miss Luxembourg 2010 competition will conclude on December 19 at the Château d'Urselt shortly after Nilles returns from the Miss World 2009 contest in Johannesburg, South Africa, where she will compete among 120 contestants. Luxembourg is returning to the Miss World competition after a 20-year absence.

Those entering the Miss Luxembourg 2009 contest must:

- Be a national of Luxembourg
- Be female
- Be close to her culture
- Have a sense of ethics
- Be between 18 and 25
- Have no criminal record
- Be single
- Not have children
- Have not have posed for indecent photos or films
